Employment and career support



<u>COVID-19 Employment and Benefits support from DWP</u>: Providing information about the changes brought in to support people who are already claiming benefits, need to claim benefits, or are at risk of losing their job as a result of coronavirus.



Education Funding: The women's section of The Royal British Legion offers two separate bursaries for eligible beneficiaries.
