

RAF UNIVERSITY SPONSORSHIP SCHEMES

Two University Sponsorship schemes:

Defence Technical Undergraduate Scheme (DTUS)

University Air Squadron Bursary Scheme (UAS BS)

The closing date for applications to both DTUS and UAS BS is end of Jan each year. Late applications will be considered on a case by case basis in accordance with Service need.

Defence Technical Undergraduate Scheme (DTUS)

- For Engineering and Logistics Officers only.
- The DTUS Bursary Scheme is £4000 a year for years one to three. Extra year payable for a Masters degree if requested and approved.
- DTUS Universities are; Strathclyde, Oxbridge, Newcastle, Northumbria, Loughborough, Birmingham, Aston Portsmouth and Southampton.
- Applications for DTUS accepted from students, at university or currently in their Upper Sixth year at school/Year 13 or Scottish equivalent.

University Air Squadron Bursary Scheme (UAS BS)

- For Pilots, RPAS Pilot, WSO, Engineers, Drs, ABM, ATC, Intelligence, Personnel Support, RAF Regiment, Logistics Officers and Linguists.
- Applications for UASBS are only accepted from candidates already at any UK University.
- For all branches, except for Sponsored Engineering Officer Undergraduates, the UAS Bursary is a maximum of £6,000 payable in years two and three for a 3 year degree or, in years two, three and four for a 4 year degree.
- For Sponsored Engineering Officer Undergraduates, the Bursary Scheme is £4000 a year for years one to three. Extra year payable for a Masters degree if requested and approved.
- Medical Cadetship available for final 2 years at Medical School.
- Candidates applying for Foundation Degrees at Universities will not be considered for sponsorship.
